

Web application

- Client is the web browser
- Common applications
 - Webmail
 - Purchasing sites
 - Youtube
 - etc

CGI

- Computer Gateway Interface
 - "CGI Scripts"
- One of the first mechanisms for generating web pages dynamically
- RFC 3875
- Provides a server-side execution environment with access to certain client-transmitted data
 - lacktriangle And of course, the server's data

 - Prefork
- mod perl
- mod php

- 3-Tier: Client, Webserver, Database
 - Presentation, Application, Data

Model-View-Controller (MVC)

- Problem UI needs frequent modification without impacting system's functionality
- Solution break system into three components - model, view, and controller
 - controller mediates between the model and the view





MVC

- Model contains underlying classes
 - Instances are viewed and manipulated
- View contains objects that render the appearance (UI) of data from the model
- Controller contains objects that control and handle user's interaction with the view and the model

MVC on the WWW

- View component generates HTML
 - Displayed by browser
- Controller interprets HTTP POSTs from the browser
- Model is the underlying system
 - Manages the information

Ajax

- Historic: something changes, reload the page
- AJAX: Asynchronous Javascript and XML
- ~2005, allows client to be more interactive
 - Dynamic interaction with the DOM
 - Asynchronous interactions with server
 - Decouples data and presentation
 - Often JSON instead of XML now

JSON

- JavaScript Object Notation
- Attribute-value pairs
- Human readable
- Serializes data

Sessions

- Session token sent from server to client
 - Usually stored as a HTTP cookie
 - Or a parameter in GET/POST
- Session data stored on the server
 - Sometimes in a database, sometimes elsewhere
 - PHP session_start() puts something in /var/lib/php/session (CentOS)

Cookies

- Data stored on client
- Mechanism for clients to remember state
- Log in somewhere and choose to have it remember you?
 - That's a cookie
 - Authentication cookie

Tracking cookies

- Often used by advertisers
- Website loads an ad from some other domain
 - lacksquare Sets up a cookie
- Other sites that also load ads from that domain reference the cookie
 - Allows advertisers to identify an entity and track their browsing habits

Cloud Computing

- Bzzzzzzzzzzzzz bzz bzzzz
- Pay someone else to run your server
- Don't have to worry about hardware/infrastructure costs
 - They're included
- Depending on the offering, system administration may be included
- Or even applications
